Methodology

Restaurante-Escola SENAC Casa do Comercio's carbon footprint has been prepared, ensuring the principles of Relevance, Completeness, Consistency, Transparency, and Accuracy, and following the calculation and reporting methods and principles that appear in the:

- ISO 14064-1:2018 - Greenhouse gases.
- The GHG Protocol: A Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard.
- IPCC Guidelines for National Greenhouse Gas Inventories.
- IPCC Fifth Assessment Report.

Reporting period: This carbon footprint has taken 2021 as the time limit, from January 1 of 2021 to December 31 of 2021.

Reporting limits: Scopes 1, 2, and 3 have been considered.

Results

Overall GHG emissions: 820.01 tCO₂eq

Scope 1: 29.00 tCO₂eq

Scope 2: 49.57 tCO₂eq

Scope 3: 741.44 tCO₂eq

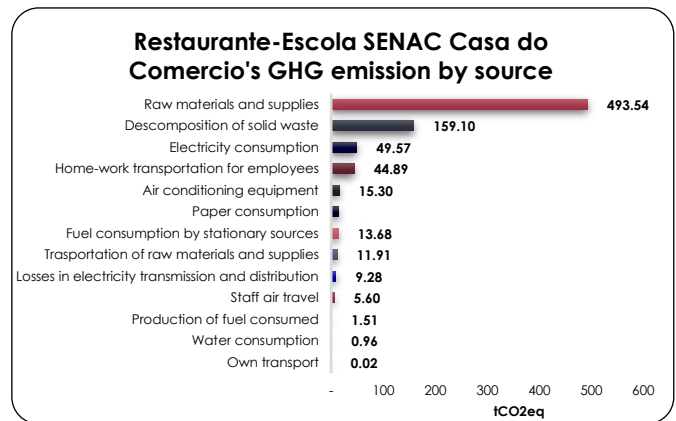

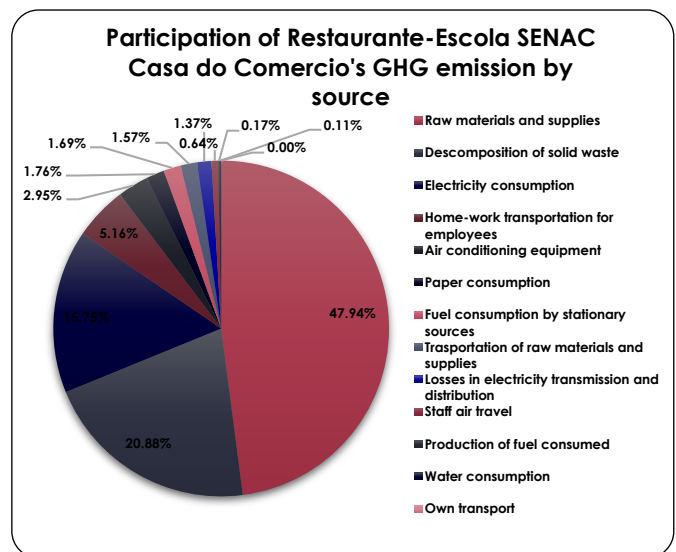


GHG EMISSIONS BY SOURCES

- Raw materials and supplies resulted in 493.54 tCO₂eq.
- Decomposition of solid waste generated a total of 159.10 tCO₂eq.
- Electricity consumption generated 49.57 tCO₂eq.



- Raw materials and supplies represented 47.94% being the most significant source of total GHG emissions.



GHG INDICATORS

- The Core indicator was estimated based on Restaurante-Escola SENAC Casa do Comercio's number of clients (45,080 clients).
