DESTINO TURÍSTICO DE BONITO CARBON FOOTPRINT

The Serra da Bodoquena comprises the cities of Bonito, Jardim, and Bodoquena, which together form the "Destino Turístico de Bonito". Bonito is the main city, concentrating most tourism-related services, and tourism stands out as the region's main economic activity.

Methodology

Destino Turístico de Bonito's carbon footprint has been prepared, ensuring the principles of Relevance, Completeness, Consistency, Transparency, and Accuracy, and following the calculation and reporting methods and principles that appear in the:

- Global Protocol for Community-Scale
 Greenhouse Gas Inventories
- IPCC Guidelines for National Greenhouse Gas Inventories.
- IPCC Fifth Assessment Report.

Reporting period: This carbon footprint has taken 2021 as the time limit, from January 1 of 2021 to December 31 of 2021.

Reporting limits: Scopes 1, 2, and 3 have been considered.

Results

Overall GHG emissions: 9,486.28 †CO₂eq **Scopes 1:** 5,522.02 †CO₂eq **Scopes 2:** 1,073.87 †CO₂eq **Scopes 3:** 2,890.39 †CO₂eq






GHG EMISSIONS BY

- Fuel consumption by mobile sources resulted in 5,035.80 tCO₂eq.
- Descomposition of solid waste generated a total of 1,377.88 tCO₂eq.
- Production of fuel consumed generated 1,311.38 tCO₂eq.



• Fuel consumption by mobile sources represented 53.09%, being the most significant source of total GHG emissions.
