By joining worldwide stakeholders committed to achieving the goals of the Paris Agreement, while also supporting the achievement of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal 13: Climate Action.

will actively, contribute to accelerating the transformational change essential to achieve net-zero² global greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 2050 or earlier through its commitment to the climate and nature-positive action³.

The Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) emphasizes the urgency of limiting global temperature rise to just 1.5°C above pre-industrial levels, a goal underscored by unequivocal scientific evidence. At present, Earth has already experienced an increase of approximately 1.1°C since the late 1800s, and greenhouse gas emissions are on an upward trajectory. Adhering to the Paris Agreement's target of limiting global warming to no more than 1.5°C and according to United Nations is necessary a substantial reduction in emissions by 2030, followed by achieving carbon neutrality by 2050.

Therefore, our organization⁴ will undertake the following immediate actions:

- 1. Quantify (measure) our greenhouse gas emissions considering Scope 1, 2 and 3 (if apply), all operations along its value-chain, and in all jurisdictions;
- 2. Set targets, plan and implement actions to reduce those emissions;
- 3. Consider contributing to further global emission reductions and sustainable development through the use of credible carbon credits⁵;
- 4. Progresively phase-out of fossil fuels and scale up renewable energy;
- 5. Consider the possibility of enhancing carbon removals by planting trees or actively participating in the conservation of forests.
